



Bed Bug Treatment Preparation List:

- ___ Empty clothing from dressers and place them into bags to be laundered.
- ___ Empty closets of clothing and place them into bags to be laundered.
- ___ Wash all linens, bedding materials, clothing, stuffed animals, etc., in the highest allowable water temperature and dry on the hottest allowable heat setting. After drying place these items in sealed bags until further instructed.
- ___ Remove curtains from curtain rods and dry on highest setting for 30 minutes.
- ___ Remove any boxes or bins from under your bed.
- ___ Purchase a mattress encasement that fits the size of your bed.
- ___ Purchase a box spring encasement that fits the size of your box spring.
- ___ Remove electrical outlet plates from the wall.
- ___ Vacuum floors, carpets and area rugs. Use the crack and crevice attachment around baseboards, bed frames, sofas, and other furniture items. Discard vacuum bags or contents after use. If you have a canister vacuum, please clean the canister with rubbing alcohol after each use.
- ___ Remove books from book shelves and put into bags or bins in the center of the room.
- ___ Remove all miscellaneous items from dressers, night stands, chests, etc. and place the items in plastic bags.
- ___ All luggage that has been used recently during travel must remain empty so that it may be inspected and treated if necessary.
- ___ All people and any pets must remain out of the home/apartment during treatment and at-least a minimum of 3 hours after the treatment is complete. Fish, and reptile tanks must be covered or removed. Air filters and filtration systems for aquatic fish should be turned off during treatment.
