



Post Treatment Recommendation Checklist

- ___ Please keep bagged items bagged for **at least** two weeks unless otherwise noted. You may open your clothing bags to pick out clothes for the day but be sure to seal it back up when done.
- ___ Please Install your mattress and boxspring encasement after the treatment if not already done.
- ___ You **may** see live bugs and have bed bug activity for at least 10 days after treatment. This does happen and is considered normal. Keep in mind the products leave a residual and are still active for weeks after treatment. Please let us know if you do find any bugs and do your best to save them alive in a zip lock bag or glass jar.
- ___ Put a fresh set of washed sheets on bed after treatment is done or the next time you sleep in the bed.
- ___ Please do not wet mop the floors for 7-14 days after treatment. Using cleaning products may neutralize the chemicals and render them ineffective. The residual of the products are what are actively killing the bed bugs after the treatment. You may sweep and vacuum the floors.
- ___ You may sleep in the bed tonight unless otherwise noted. (Pregnant women please give 24 hours from treatment time)
- ___ You can invite friends and family over but remember to be nice and alert them that you have had bed bugs.
- ___ If you haven't already, it may be a good idea to alert building management (If you live in an multiunit dwelling)
- ___ You can re-enter about 3-5 hours after treatment unless specified otherwise.
